## Brown County's Geologic Wonders

Join us for a captivating morning of learning about the detailed geology of the Niagara Escarpment in Brown County as we explore two of the County's most notable parks: Wequiock Falls and Bay Shore Park.

Our tour guide is the very knowledgeable geologist, Dr. John Luczaj from UW-Green Bay. Dr. Luczaj recently completed new geologic research and mapping of the County and will share newly uncovered interesting features and phenomena about Wisconsin's Niagara Escarpment!

The tour will begin at Wequiock Falls and the group will caravan to Bay Shore Park, several miles up the road. The walking tours at these two sites will point out the intricacies of the unique geology beneath our feet and help you to understand the ancient history of the Niagara Escarpment, as well as the reasons for current concerns regarding the impacts of development along its corridor. We will conclude the tour at Bay Shore County Park and caravan a short distance for an informal lunch (on your own) at Lipsky's Pizza in Dyckesville on Hwy. 57 (Exit DK).
